The Shared Anti-life Goals of Gates, Sanger and Hitler

Billionaire Bill Gates, cofounder of Microsoft, is up to his old tricks.

Last year, he hired a socalled "conservative" lobbyist as his Capitol Hill mouthpiece to help gut the immigration legislation so Microsoft could continue to have unlimited access to foreign software engineers who work for lower wages than do American citizens. In his business, he's known as a predator and modern-day robber-baron. Last year's action shows him also to be anti-American and contemptuous of the democratic process.

Recently, Gates and his wife Melinda pledged \$2,250,000 over a five year period to the Johns Hopkins School of Public Health for the promotion of worldwide population control. The Baltimore Sun reported on May 15, 1997 that the Gates money is to be used by JHU's Family Planning Leadership Education Institute "based in the department of population dynamics to offer training for health leaders [i.e. baby killers] in underdeveloped nations to hold down birthrates in those countries."

When announcing his gift, Gates wrote "Melinda and I are anxious that the wonderful progress which has been made in diminishing the world's potentially disastrous birthrate over the last 30 years continues. We believe that a critical ingredient in this progress is indigenous leadership and expertise." Johns Hopkins will work feverishly to promote planned parenthood/population control with the expectation of getting more gifts from Gates in the future. Gates is anti-life as well as being anti-American.

Bill Gates displays the same population control mentality that motivated Planned Parenthood's founder Margaret Sanger. Ex-Catholic-turned-atheist Sanger who in 1921 founded the American Birth Control League which was the precursor to Planned Parenthood, hated life and embraced evil. Sanger, like most evil-doers, attempts to conceal her motives with claims of doing good. She proclaimed that her organizations were founded to help the poor when in actuality they promoted government interference in private familv matters. In her 1932 work "Plan for Peace", Sanger called for the same coercive sterilization that was used by the Nazis and is now being used by the Chinese Communists.

Fr. Andrew O'Brien offers some startling information about Sanger, "Margaret Sanger, pioneer of birth control and founder of Planned Parenthood, was also a top Rosicrucian and a friend of Hitler. Many top Rosicrucians were sponsors of Hitler. In Sanger's Birth Control Review of 1939 appeared an article by Dr. Ernst Ruddin, a leader in Hitler's Third Reich, titled 'Eugenic Sterilization: An Urgent Need'. Two months after Germany invaded Poland, Sanger commended the Nazi birth control program in her Birth Control Review of November 1939."

O'Brien's exposé of Sanger reveals the true motivation of the population controller: hatred of Christianity. "During 1914 and 1915", writes O'Brien, "she was intimate with Havelock Ellis, who helped found the Fabian Society. [She also shared her sexual favors with several others of her Fabian Socialist comrades. ed.] In fact, Sanger was proclaimed 'Hu-

manist of the Year' in 1957. Margaret Sanger had set forth her creed in 1914, as a woman's right: "To live, to love, to be lazy, to be an unwed mother, to create, to destroy.' What she really wanted to destroy was made clear in her first newspaper The Woman Rebel in which she wrote: 'Birth control appeals to the advanced radical because it is calculated to undermine the Christian churches. I look forward to seeing humanity free someday of the tyranny of Christianity'." (Make Yourself An Ark, O'Brien, \$19 pp, American Research Foundation, P.O. Box 5687, Baltimore MD 21210)
