### COMMUNIST PLANS FOR SOUTH AFRICA

The U.S. Communists are confidently anticipating the Communist conquest of South Africa. This expectation comforts and reassures them after the unexpected collapse of Communist power in the Soviet Union and Eastern Europe.

They know that the African National Congress (ANC) has been selected by most of the business and governmental authorities in the U.S.A. and the Western world as the future government of South Africa. They also know that there is an official alliance between the South African Communist Party and the ANC, that many Communists hold positions of power within the ANC, and that the policies of the ANC are chosen, in large measure, by the Communists.

#### Following the Directions of Lenin

What are the Communists planning for South Africa? An article in the September 18 edition of the U.S. Communist newspaper, PEOPLE'S WEEKLY WORLD, reveals that they are planning to follow the instructions that Lenin gave for the consolidation of Communist power in his classical textbook, "The State and the Revolution". In this book, Lenin teaches that the Communists, after achieving power, must destroy the controlling institutions of the existing state. This is what the Communists intend to do in South Africa.

The following article in the PEOPLE'S DAILY WORLD states: "The issue dismantling the terrorist apartheid state becomes uppermost. This means destroying the military, legal and judicial foundations of the apartheid regime. Without this, full political power will be thwarted."

Consider these extracts from the article with the caption:

#### SOUTH AFRICA: WORKING CLASS ISSUES TAKE CENTER STAGE

"In this light the struggle continues. The liberation alliance, headed by the ANC, the South African Communist Party and the Congress of South African Trade Unions (COSATU), on the one side, and on the other, the ruling Nationalist Party and its international backers headed by U.S. imperialism, look at this agreement from different sides of the class and liberation struggles.

"The ANC wants to expand the power of the Black vote and to put in place the institutional basis for transforming the economy. But the Nationalist Party wishes to dilute Black voter strength and insure that the economy remains in the hands of South African and international monopoly capital. In this scheme the Black majority would remain economic second class citizens and cheap labor.

"In the light of this, the stance of the South African working class and trade union movements is significant. Last July the National Union of Metal Workers at its covention called for the nationalization of core sectors of the economy and the restructuring of industry to empower workers. The metal workers and other unions have proposed the formation of a Labor Party based on the working class and trade unions. The South African Communist Party at its last Congress declared that the anti-apartheid struggle was increasingly centering upon the demands of workers, and that after the achievement of political rights the struggle would be centered on the fight against the giant monopoly corporations...

"From this standpoint the issue of dismantling the terrorist apartheid state becomes uppermost. This means destroying the military, legal and judicial foundations of the apartheid regime. Without this, full political power will be thwarted. At the same time, without building state power rooted in the people the transformation of the economy will be virtually impossible." (Page 15)

Since, as the philosopher, George Santayana has said, "Those who cannot remember the past are condemned to repeat it," these Communist statements merit serious consideration, which should lead to appropriate action.

#### INCREASING COMMUNIST RESPECTABILITY IN THE U.S.A.

The collapse of Communist power in the Soviet Union has led to the widespread delusion that the activities of the U.S. Communists pose no threat to freedom. This delusion has led to the removal of barriers which prevented Communists from holding leading positions in certain institutions. This, in turn, has led to an increase in the subversive power of the U.S. Communists.

This increase in Communist respectability is illustrated by a profile, captioned, Art Edelman: Labor Militant, which was published in the September 18 edition of PEOPLE'S WEEKLY WORLD. The profile states:

"Edelman was elected president of the San Diego chapter of the Federation of Retired Union Members (FORUM), a California organization with 140,000 members statewide. Given his energy and enthusiasm, it would have been unremarkable but for the fact that Edelman is a publicly announced member of the Communist Party, USA. Edelman helps distribute hundreds of copies of the Party's newspaper, the PEOPLE'S WEEKLY WORLD, to General Dynamics shipyard workers and at other plant gates to San Diego every week...

"The support Edelman received for his right to belong to the Communist Party, a legal party, is not isolated. As a new generation of labor activists searches for more militant forms of struggle against ruthless unionbusting and wage chiseling, they are running into veteran Communists like Art Edelman who played such an outstanding role in helping to build the labor movement. That in turn is leading them into confrontation with the clauses in union constitutions that bar Communists from leadership or even membership."

Who said, "Communism is dead"?

## THE CONTRIBUTION OF PRESIDENT REAGAN TO THE DEATH OF SOVIET COMMUNISM, Part 2

### Peace Through Strength

President Reagan was devoted to peace, and he was convinced that the path to peace was paved with strength, not weakness. His philosophy and programs were in harmony with the words of Jesus, who said: "When a strong man, armed, keeps his palace, his goods are in peace; but when a stronger than he comes upon him, he takes from him all his armor in which he trusted and divides his spoils."

### Military Measures

The goods in the palace of Ronald Reagan were human freedom and the security of the U.S.A. He was determined that no other power on earth should be strong enough to take these "goods" away from him and us. To assure this, he took three military measures: 1) The rearming of the U.S.A., 2) The Strategic Defense Initiative (SDI), and 3) The placement of short-range nuclear weapons, including cruise missiles in Western Germany in order to deter any land attack by the forces of the Soviet Union and the Warsaw Pact against that country and Western Europe.

These measures were criticized viciously and opposed vigorously by the so-called "Peace Forces" of the U.S.A. and the world, but history has recorded that they contributed substantially to the abolition of the threat of the nuclear holocaust that would have resulted from armed conflict between the U.S.A. and the Soviet Union. It may be said truthfully that Ronald Reagan did more to preserve peace through his programs than all the proclamations, marches, rallies, demonstrations and propaganda of the so-called "peace movement".

### Economic Measures

From the time of Lenin, the Communists were confident that their economic system was superior to that of the U.S.A., and that this would lead inevitably to the replacement of the free enterprise system by "Socialism". Who can forget the proud boast of Nikita Khrushchev, "We will bury you"? Many interpreted this boast militarily, but Khrushchev later claimed that he meant it economically. Every genuine Communist was as certain of Communist economic triumph as of the rising of the morrow's sun.

This widespread Communist delusion was expressed by Khrushchev when he said,

"The liquidation of the capitalist system is the crucial question in the development of society. After the victory of the working class, working peasantry, and working intelligentsia, there will be neither social, national, nor any other causes for the outbreak of war in any country. But this will be only under the complete domination of the Socialist, communist system throughout the world. Mankind will then be united in a true commonwealth of equal nations. This was said long ago and scientifically proved by the founders of Marxism-Leninism."  
(Khrushchev Remembers, page 513)

Khrushchev's statement that there would soon be "neither social, national, nor any other causes for the outbreak of war in any country," sounds like the ravings of a lunatic when we see the enormous number of wars, caused by nationalism, that are presently engulfing the world. The September 19 edition of the LOS ANGELES TIMES published a list of 62 "Recent and Current Armed Conflicts", and this list is far from being complete.

Nevertheless, Krushchev was merely stating the seductive Marxist doctrine that "Capitalism causes war, and the triumph of Communism will abolish war," which has lured so many idealists into the Communist trap.

Well aware of Communist convictions and intentions, Reagan set out to thwart their plans to liquidate the capitalist system. One of his first steps was to increase the economic well-being of the U.S.A. During his regime, employment soared and unemployment plummeted, while inflation diminished. The indexes of social well-being soared. The misery index that plagued the Carter regime fell by more than half.

The Soviet leader, Mikhail Gorbachev, interpreted these military and economic measures as having been designed to conquer the Soviet Union. He writes:

"I shall repeat that as far as United States foreign policy is concerned, it is based on at least two delusions. The first is the belief that the economic system of the Soviet Union is about to crumble and that the USSR will not succeed in restructuring. The second is calculated on Western superiority in equipment and technology and, eventually, in the military field. These illusions nourish a policy geared toward exhausting socialism through the arms race, so as to dictate terms later. Such is the scheme; it is naive." (Perestroika, page 220)

History has now confirmed that the naive delusions were in the mind of Gorbachev, not Reagan. The Soviet people have now renounced "Socialism", and are attempting to build societies based upon free enterprise and democracy.

Nevertheless, it would be premature to consign the delusions of the Marxists to the Endangered Species list. Marxist delusions live on in the minds of the U.S. Communists and a substantial number of college professors, leftist politicians, inexperienced idealistic students, and inmates of mental institutions. ## SNARLING COMRADES

Pity Gus Hall, Chairman of the U.S. Communist Party. Maybe he is having a nervous breakdown.

In the July 31 edition of the U.S. Communist newspaper, PEOPLE'S WEEKLY WORLD, Hall published a passionate plea to those ex-members, who had recently left the Communist Party, to return to the fold; saying, in effect, "All is forgiven". Now, in the September 11 edition of the Communist newspaper, he attacks them viciously and calls them "thieves" and "scoundrels". He writes:

"A handful of individuals, including ex-Communists, Trotskyites and various others, mostly grouped into the Committees of Correspondence, decided to seize-- in fact steal--properties and assets belonging to the Communist Party. This property included our office building and bookstore at 522 Valencia Street in San Francisco, the equipment and other assets therein, Pacific Publishing Company and all the wills bequeathed to these properties."

Who are these "thieves" and "scoundrels" to whom Hall is referring? They are his close, life-long trusted friends and associates in the U.S. Communist Party, who recently resigned from the Party. They include such well-known people as Herbert Aptheker, who was generally regarded as the leading theoretician of U.S. Communism, and Angela Davis. Hall writes:

"The Party established the policy of asking supporters wishing to leave property and/or money to the Party to bequeath these assets to trusted individual Party leaders, rather than the Party itself. This was to protect both the individual donors and the Party."

Those whom Hall calls "thieves" and "scoundrels" were "trusted Party leaders". They had been chosen and appointed trustees for the present and future assets of the U.S. Communist Party. When leaving the Party, they attempted to take these assets with them. Hall writes: "When they left the Party this grouping refused to turn over the Party's property and finances, as well as records."

### Legal Action

He describes the actions which the Communist Party took:

"We first demanded that our property be returned to us. They refused. Their claim was that the property and resources they seized belonged to the individuals who were named as members of directors of these properties, appointed to those positions by the Party and entrusted to protect its interests. The total value of this property is well over a million dollars. Thus, the Party was forced to file a legal suit to regain our property."

### The Verdict

The court ruled:

"The court finds that the assets in question belong to the Communist Party of the United States of America and that defendants wrongfully retained those assets

after ending their affiliation with the Party.

"The evidence is clear that plaintiff [the Communist Party] set up the corporations, financed them, benefited from them, and controlled them in all respects...

"Accordingly, the individual defendants must return the assets and account to the plaintiff."

### Applause For Bourgeois Justice

Hall has spent a lifetime maligning the U.S. system of justice, claiming that it is an instrument by which the bosses oppress the workers. Nevertheless, he pays it a glowing tribute when he writes: "The judge ruled on the basis of law, legal rights, equity, and fair play."

If the Communists were ruling America, the outcome of this intra-party dispute would not have been so bloodless.

### The Achilles Heel of Communism

This conflict reveals the Achilles heel of Communism, which dooms it to abysmal failure. For their program to have any chance of success, they would have to create conditions which would produce unselfish and efficient people. Marxism claims that such people can be produced in abundance by creating the right economic environment.

If the Marxist claim were true, it would be reasonable to expect that the evidence for the increasing perfection of human nature would appear first within the ranks of the Communists themselves. It has been a proud boast of the Communists that they are people with special qualities which entitle them to rule the mass of mankind. The slogan which was blazoned on the headquarters of the Communist Party, when it ruled the Soviet Union, was: "The Communist Party is the mind, the conscience, and the morals of our epoch".

The Communist claim for special virtue now seems as preposterous as the words on the ruins of the statue of Ozymandias-- "Look on my works ye mighty, and despair".

### Common Communist Conduct

The Communist Party member is alleged to display complete selflessness in his attitude and activity. As the Chinese Communist theoretician, Liu Shao-Chi, stated: "Whether or not a Communist Party member can absolutely and unconditionally subordinate his personal interests to the party's interests under all circumstances is the criterion by which to test his loyalty to the Party, to the revolution and to the Communist cause."

Such is the theory. How different it is from the practice. Every Communist Party finds that its members abound in personal pride, greed, and envy, so that corruption and strife become routine.

How these Communists hate one another!

## GOOD NEWS FOR A CHANGE

Most bad things in the Los Angeles area have been growing worse year by year. It is a special pleasure, therefore, to be able to report one bad thing that is improving.

Consider this statement in an article in the October, 1993 edition of the magazine, SCIENTIFIC AMERICAN, by James M. Lents and William J. Kelley of the South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD):

"Los Angeles is one of the few places in the nation where air quality has improved dramatically since the 1970s. From 1955 to 1992 the peak level ozone--one of the best indicators of air pollution--declined from 680 parts per billion to 300 parts per billion. The California Air Resources Board recently documented that population exposure to unhealthful ozone levels has been cut in half in just the past decade. Furthermore, the smog levels measured during each of the past three years have been the lowest on record.

"All these improvements were achieved at a time when human activity in the Los Angeles area was increasing at a rapid rate. Since the 1950s the population has almost tripled, from 4.8 million to 14 million; the number of motor vehicles on the road has more than quadrupled, from 2.3 million to 10.6 million; and the city has grown into one of the most prosperous regions of the world."

This provides a beacon of hope that the problem of physical pollution can be solved. We must now seek a solution to the even more deadly problem of moral pollution.

## SENATOR MOYNIHAN TELLS IT LIKE IT IS

Senator Daniel Moynihan was the guest on the N.B.C. program, "Meet The Press", September 19. He was asked how he would account for the juvenile crim wave that is engulfing America, which was illustrated by the shooting of a tourist in Florida by a 14-year-old boy who had previously been arrested 53 times.

The Senator replied that the breakdown of the family had created a predatory underclass of conscienceless young males whose only concern was the gratification of their own appetites. They had no hesitation in killing any individual in order to gain his or her property.

When asked, "What can we do to change this situation?" The Senator replied passionately, "We can, and should, take every possible measure to assure that every child who is born, be given his basic human right to be nurtured and reared by both mother and FATHER."

One practical step towards this objective would be to restore the tax deduction for dependents to the inflation-adjusted value it had previously. As Dr. James Dobson of Focus on the Family points out, the \$600 deduction per dependent that was granted when he was a boy, would now be worth \$8,000.



## RAMPANT FEMINIST SEXISM

The Communists always claim to be the legitimate representatives of the working class. Some of them sincerely believe this delusion. Many others have been deceived and entrapped by this claim.

The radical feminists, such as those who control the organization. "National Organization for Women (NOW)", claim to be the legitimate representatives of the majority of women. It is probable that some of them actually believe this delusion, though they are only an elitist minority. They have persuaded many in authority to take their false claim seriously.

One of the great "crimes" which these feminists rave against is sexism. Webster's dictionary defines sexism as, "The economic exploitation and social domination of one sex by another." The feminists claim that men and women should always be treated equally, without discrimination.

While railing against sexism, many feminists practice it. They demand special and different treatment for women. One example of this is their reaction to the arrest and indictment of a woman, Heidi Fleiss, for selling the services of prostitutes to Hollywood stars and others. The LOS ANGELES TIMES of Saturday, August 7, carries an article under the caption, "Feminists Decry Fleiss Prosecution as Unequal Justice". The article states:

"A Los Angeles women's organization and a feminist lawyer Friday denounced the prosecution of alleged madam to the stars Heidi Fleiss, calling on police to 'put as much energy and effort into the arrest of the johns' as they have put into their pursuit of Fleiss.

"Attorney Gloria Allred called it a double standard to pursue Fleiss so aggressively while Fleiss' rich and powerful Hollywood customers are getting off the hook.

"'It seems to me that if a person alleged to be a madam is being prosecuted, then law enforcement should be equally concerned with male customers.' Allred said in an interview. She further criticized the investigation Friday night in a speech titled 'Poetic Injustice' delivered to a meeting of the National Assn. of Woman Lawyers in New York.

"Separately, the Los Angeles chapter of the National Organization for Women charged that the law enforcement effort that led to Fleiss' arrest 'indicates a system that still doesn't get it'."

The legal principle that the seller and promoter of an illegal product may be more culpable than those who buy the product is well-established. Are not the salesmen of illegal drugs, such as cocaine and heroin, punished more severely by the law than those who buy the drugs? Do not the liberals demand understanding and treatment, rather than punishment, for the users of illegal drugs, while supporting the arrest and punishment of the merchandisers?

The protest against the arrest and indictment of the promoter and provider of the illegal product, prostitution, is because the promoter is a woman. If a man were the culprit, there would be no protest. This is an example of the rampant sexism which the feminists protest so vehemently.
