a panel of six speakers, voicing their views on "Psychiatric Im-plications of Surveys on Sexual Benavior," had accused 'Dr. Kinsey of "naiveté in his approach" to; the investigation of female sexuality as represented by the book "Sexual Behavior in the Human Female."

Human Female." Dr. Menninger asserted that the bolk was "a shocking mis-representation of female sexual-it?" and that "one does not take at face yalue what 5,000 talkative wohen fell him." He argued that Dr. Kinbey had ignored "love" as a vital aspect of human ackuality. Dr. Kinsey, a member of Indiana University's faculity, told his listenets he was speaking as a biologist. He declared he had been in esubject of "shallow criticigm" and that he and his associates have had to "light for funds and the right to do this study." study.
