ITEM: The cover story, "What We Know About Sex." in USA Weekend for November 7-9, was produced jointly with the Kinsey Institute for Research in Sex. Gender and Reproduction. Therein, Institute director John Bancroft provides a "prescription for a healthier society." This includes: "Respect all varieties of sexual expression, as long as they are handled responsibly. Sexual responsibility, Bancroft says, means protecting against disease and unwanted pregnancy, avoiding causing physical or psychological harm to ourselves and our partners, participating only in truly consensual sex and avoiding the sexual exploitation of those too young to make responsible decisions."

BETWEEN THE LINES: Nowhere in the apologia for deviance can you find the words spouse, husband or wife. Of course, Kinsey and his followers think no sexual behavior is abnormal. Indeed, Kinsey's most celebrated study claimed that 40-50 percent of American farm boys had sex with animals.

Alfred Kinsey not only had a homosexual bias but also a pederast bias, notes Dr. Judith Reisman. She and several colleagues have compiled extensive exposés on Kinsey and his studies. In his research, for instance, Kinsey sought out sex offenders, prison inmates, male prostitutes and ex-cons — then extrapolated from his findings about their behavior. Moreover, in her book *Kinsey, Sex and Fraud*, Dr. Reisman presents convincing evidence that Kinsey and those he trained sexually tortured children.
