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# RSVP works to discredit Kinsey fraud

There are some who believe there is a much worse blight on Indiana University than Bobby Knight. It is a blight the school has sheltered and protected far longer than it has defended its errant basketball coach. It is a blight IU should have "fired" 52 years ago.

This small but dedicated group of scientists, doctors, attorneys and Christian laymen are determined to destroy what they call "a half-century legacy of evil" at IU.

Their mission is to expose its "lies and depravity," and to systematically dismantle the web of bad laws and flawed education programs it has spawned.



Their weapon: Information. Their target: IU's Kinsey Institute for the Study of Human Sexuality.

In August, Christian physicians, scientists, lawyers and parents from all across America gathered near Crestwood, Ky., to hear famed researcher Dr. Judith Reisman explain how Dr. Alfred Kinsey's

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liberately skewed findings about iman sexuality had moved Amera from chastity to condoms in a ngle generation.

She detailed how data he gathred using research methods that vouldn't meet the requirements of a third-grade science fair had been used to change laws regarding obscenity, prostitution, rape, adultery, pomography and pedophelia all across America—and served as the sole basis for the American Psychiatric Association's decision to take homosexuality off its list of psychological disorders.

The group that met at Foxhollow Retreat talked about what people could and should do to fight Kinsey's influence in society.

"It's a disgusting subject that Christians understandably don't want to think about or hear about, much less talk about," said Eunice Ray, who with her husband Ret. U.S.Army Col. Ronald Ray founded a campaign to Restore Social Virtue and Purity to America. RSVP America sponsored Reisman's appearance in August in Kentucky.

"But you can't fight an evil you don't know is there," she said. "When you know about Kinsey, when you know what he did, why his data is completely fraudulent, and the incredible harm his misinformation has caused, you're no longer powerless. You can stand up in that school textbook committee meeting and say, 'That sex education program is totally bogus, and I can prove it!' Armed with information, we can fight back; ignorant, we and future generations will forever be victims of Kinsey's depravity."

Reisman echoed Ray's sentiments during her Kentucky visit, telling the group that it would certainly be easier to "ignore the garbage in the Kinsey reports."

"But with a clear understanding of Kinsey, we can fight back to restore virtue to our country," Reisman said. "Even today, 50 years later, Kinsey continues to influence our courts, schools, the medical community and social services."

When a kindergarten teacher holds up a condom and talks about "safe sex and AIDS to children barely able to tie their own shoes," that's a direct result of Alfred Kinsey's fraudulent research back in the 1930s, Reisman explained. So are countless other scenes in American life—upscale bookstores that stock child pornography in the art section, graphic sex in movies, and teachers teaching second-graders the lie that "gay is good" and "one in 10 of you is gay."

#### Fraudulent research

"Science is supposed to be objective, unbiased and validated," Reisman said.

Honest science tests hypotheses and looks for the truth. But "the data from Kinsey's reports were never replicated or validated."

Kinsey's first mistake was lying about himself, Reisman told the packed room of grassroots leaders from many states. While Indiana University portrayed Kinsey as a stereotypical family man and academic," Reisman explained that Kinsey insider and biographer James Jones refuted that claim. Raised in a strict, religious home, Kinsey set out on a personal mission to free America from sexual repression-to unhinge America from God and biblical standards. Jones' book Alfred Kinsey, A Public Private Life, exposed Kinsey's obsession with pornograhy, homosexuality, and deviant sexual prac-

Kinsey's lifestyle and personal aganda alone were enough to derail the Kinsey reports as objective science. But the fraud went even deeper. Reisman pointed out that Kinsey's researcher, Clyde; Martin, had no training in statistical analysis.

"All the data in Kinsey's books was flawed because it was wrapped around fraudulent charts and graphs no one understood," she said.

Kinsey's relationship with Martin tainted the data, as well. Reisman said that in 1930, Kinsey hired Clyde Martin to take care of his yard, later forming a homosexual relationship with him and another associate, Wardell Pomeroy. Before long, Kinsey promoted Martin to statistician and Pomeroy to coauthor of his studies.

"One of Kinsey's claims to fame was the huge population studied," Reisman continued.

Even that was a lie. According to Kinsey insider William Simon, while Kinsey interviewed 18,000 people, he used only about a quarter of the cases in his reports (Sexuality and Homosexuality, 1971, p. 456). Reisman emphasized that objective science cannot pick and choose among data.

"Roughly 80 percent of Kinsey's male subjects were sexual deviants," she said. "Kinsey admitted to including 1,600 sex felons in his research. Jones' biography said that Kinsey gathered subjects by trolling gay bars and nightclubs. In his scholarly textbooks, however, Kinsey portrayed those men as normal. Fathers and married men were systematically excluded from his studies."

Other fraud was so absurd that average common sense could easily expose it. Yet the scientific community was silent, openly embracing Kinsey's model of sexuality.

In the 1930s, Kinsey claimed that 95 percent of males were sex offenders, that 50 percent of all men engaged in adultery, that 65 percent of the men and 50 percent of the women engaged in premarital sex, and that 90 percent of single women were having abortions. None of it made sense, Reisman said.

She pointed out that those statistics, gathered from interviews with sex offenders, put together by someone with no statistical training, radically reformed American thought and culture concerning sex.

"In 1948, half of the states in the U.S. had the death penalty for rape." Reisman said. "Kinsey claimed that out of 4,441 women studied, none had been harmed by rape, even as a child. He also claimed that girls benefited from sexual contact with adult men."

Later, rape laws in many states were eased, with lighter sentences and fewer convictions.

Kinsey also skewed the research regarding adult women. When warned that normal women would not talk to him about their sex lives, Kinsey redefined marriage as "a woman who lived with a man for at least a year."

"That redefinition of marriage included hundreds of prostitutes, skewing results of the research and defaming American women, especially wives and mothers," Reisman said.

Criminal activity in the Kinsey reports

Though tens of thousands of scientists reviewed and accepted the Kinsey reports, not one exposed the sexual abuse of as many as 1,800 children until Dr. Reisman discovered it on Tables 30-34 in 1981. Those tables detailed the sexual responses of children 2 months of age to 10 years old. While other scientists saw charts and figures, Reisman saw children, hundreds upon hundreds of them, molested to prove Kinsey's hopelessly depraved view of child sexuality.

"Kinsey elevated a group of pedophiles to the status of child sex experts and their brutal activities became part of his data." Reisman explained.

To gather data, Reisman said that the "Kinsey team sought, used, encouraged and paid men to molest children." Through those bogus reports, Kinsey defamed normal, innocent children.

"Kinsey and his team of socalled researchers should be in prison," Reisman said indignantly. "The bottom line of all Kinsey's research was to say that all sex should be accepted and legal, even for juveniles. It was fraudulent, and it was criminal."

## Kinsey shifts the culture in America

During the second half of the 20th century, Americans who'd bought into the Kinsey lie found out that free love wasn't so free after all, Reisman said. After 1948, the Kinsey frauds led to social disaster: pornography, promiscuity, abortion, no-fault divorce, 25 new sexually transmitted diseases and a massive increase in sex crimes against children.

"The real issue is not just that Dr. Kinsey's findings were wrong, but that those findings have been used to shift our culture toward sexual anarchy," Reisman concluded. "Laws and public policy have abandoned Christian principles on the authority of the Kinsey's research."

Morris Ernst, a founding member of the ACLU (American Civil Liberties Union), was Kinsey's attorney. In the early 1950s, he urged every bar association in the country to establish a committee on the laws of sexual behavior. The Rockefeller Foundation, who funded Kinsey, also supported the creation of the

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American Law Institute's Model Penal Code. The code adopted Kinsey's findings, saying that sex crime in America was completely out of touch with the realities of life.

That Model Penal Code has had devastating consequences: the elimination or trivialization of sex offenses, reducing the penalties for murder, rape, child battery, desertion, seduction, adultery, prostitution, contributing to the delinquency of a minor, sodomy, obscenity, infanticide, premeditated transmission of AIDS and veneral disease.

Thanks to the Kinsey Institute, sexually violent criminals, including rapists-murderers are commonly paroled within 5 to 10 years, Reisman said.

#### Taking a stand

Eunice Ray described the devastation that followed Kinsey.

"Our generation accepted Kinsey's view that everyone is sexually active," Ray explained. "Are we, as a nation, better off if every indication of sexual disease and dysfunction is off the charts post-Kinsey?"

"While Kinsey's data is alive and

well, America is much sicker and weaker for it," Ray told the group at the end of the meeting."We need to rise up and ask school boards, teachers and legislators, 'By what authority are you doing this?""

"We can challenge Kinsey on the facts because of Dr. Reisman's research," Ray continued. "We can look at something as simple as Hepatitis B shots, now routinely given to infants in America. This is a homosexual and dirty-needle disease. Why are children the Center for Disease Control admits are not at risk for the disease, drawn into this immunization campaign?"

"When Kinsey came on the scene," Ray concluded, "our generation was sleeping. We were caught off guard. Some of us are part of those statistics. But it's time to clean house. This is a matter of the heart, a matter of grace and the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ."

### What you can to do help:

 Serve on school textbook selection committees, using Reisman's data to discredit sex education books founded on Kinsey's research.

Each school's committee is composed of three teachers, two parents and the principal. To serve on a committee, meet with the school's principal and volunteer for the position. If the principal does not appoint you to the committee, meet with the school's site-based management council and ask the council to place your name before the council for election to the committee.

· Parents, check all sex education material your children bring home from school, and use Reisman's data to approach school authorities about making changes.

·Lobby those who represent you in Frankfort to re-examine state laws on sex crimes, using accurate data that is now available in all areas Kinsey first studied.

·Lobby the officials who represent you in Washington to demand a federal investigation of the
